Adelaide University Touch Club	Purchase of equipment to assist our State Cup campaign in 2011 and beyond.
Aldinga Bay Croquet Club	Funds to lay paving to provide disabled and machinery access to croquet courts. Purchase and erect ball containment barriers around the croquet courts.
BMW Netball Club	Purchase of equipment to be used for training over 100 members, aged 5 – 40.
Equestrian Park Aldinga Inc	Towards the purchase of a quad bike and weed spray tank – for more efficient and safe maintenance.
Fencing SA	Purchase of equipment for school development program.
Spalding Bowling Club	To purchase and install a retractable shade sail.
Special Olympics Australia (SA)	Purchase of equipment for Community Sports-Link program which provides people with an intellectual disability the opportunity to participate in local sport and recreational activities.
Trinity Gardens Bowling Club	To purchase a portable hydration station to enable convenient access to cool water at the Bowling green in use.
