### **DENSO Bright Pegasus Spring Training Camp**

Japanese pro softball team Denso Bright Pegasus chose Adelaide for their spring training camp in January this year – the first time an international women’s softball team has ever chosen Adelaide as its training location. In collaboration with the Office for Recreation and Sport, Softball SA organised a “Women’s Summer Slam” – a four game series involving Aussie Spirit, our women’s national team and Denso Bright Pegasus. The series, held over the Australia Day long weekend was officiated by local South Australian coaches, scorers, umpires and team managers, live-streamed by Spacequake Sports, and attracted almost 43,000 spectators.
