



SPORT SA AWARDS NOMINATION CRITERIA

Criteria - Sport SA Volunteer of the Year

The Sport SA Volunteer of the Year will be an individual who contributes on a voluntary basis to sport in South Australia over the last twelve months. The recipient of this award may be an administrator, coach, official or undertake multiple roles and does not receive remuneration (other than reimbursement for expenses incurred or a true honorarium) in respect of their duties.

Criteria- Sport SA Official of the Year

The Sport SA Official of the Year will be an individual who has attained a level of excellence in the field of officiating e.g. refereeing / umpiring / judging / medical services / technical officer and whose performance sets them apart from their peers. This award recognises an outstanding South Australian official who has demonstrated dedication, skill knowledge and expertise in officiating at any level or who has made a significant contribution to the standard of officiating in the state.

Criteria - Sport SA Administrator of the Year

The Sport SA Administrator of the Year will be an individual who has made a significant contribution to their sport or the sport industry as a whole. As a result of the nominees' contributions, sport in South Australia will have benefited and they will have set such standards of excellence to have set themselves apart from their peers.

Criteria – Richard Newman Primary School Sports Award

Awarded to a Primary School student aimed at recognising and rewarding outstanding sporting achievements of young people within our community.

Criteria – Secondary School Sports Award

Awarded to a Secondary School student aimed at recognising and rewarding outstanding sporting achievements of young people within our community.

Criteria - Sport SA Country Athlete of the Year

The Sport SA Country Athlete of the Year is a resident in the country regions of South Australia who has achieved outstanding sporting success in SA country competitions. A country competition is defined as events centred outside the areas defined by SA Government as Adelaide and Adelaide Hills.

Criteria - Sport SA Coach of the Year

The Sport SA Coach of the Year will be an individual who has made a significant contribution to the success of a person/s or team that they have coached or been the major cause for an increased standard of coaching in the sport with which they have been associated. The Coach of the Year Award recognises outstanding performance by a South Australian Coach based on their results for athlete/s they coach and excellence in coaching practices at any level.

Criteria - Sport SA Significant Event of the Year

Awarded to a state sporting event largely organised by a state sporting body that has achieved a high standard of excellence and selection is based on the resources and work force used to deliver the event.

Criteria - Sport SA Community Event of the Year

Awarded to a state sporting event largely organised by a state sporting body that has achieved a high standard of excellence and selection is based on the resources and work force used to deliver the event.

- Notes:** (1) Organisation must be a member of Sport SA, or a club affiliated with a Sport SA member. Club nominations must be endorsed by the State Sporting Organisation (who is a member of Sport SA).
- (2) Only required if the nominating organisation is not the State Sporting Organisation.
- (3) Only one nomination per organisation
