If your passion lies in running competitions or developing sporting potential, then studying a Diploma of Sport Development (SIS50612) is perfect for you.

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge for an individual intending to pursue a career in sport development and coaching. Once you have become qualified you could find yourself working as a sport development officer for a national sporting body, a competition manager or a talent identification manager. You could be working in a variety of environments which could include sport facilities and schools or you may choose to continue your studies and gain a higher qualification.

Entry Requirements:

Completion of Year 12 or equivalent and it is recommended that you currently work or have experience in the sporting industry.

Course Duration and Delivery:

This course is self-paced, using a blended learning approach of on-line, work-book and face-to-face delivery. Each student also has access to the numerous workshops that Sport SA host every year to increase your skills and knowledge whilst networking within the industry.

Course Cost:

Course cost is \$3,600. Payment plans are available.
